IN THE MATTER AUTHORIZING NEW PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES PURSUANT TO NEWLY ADOPTED AND REVISED DOUGLAS COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS

Whereas, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution C.E. 21-38B on December 14, 2021 authorizing new legal descriptions and the maps of the voter precincts and commissioner districts in Douglas County, Washington; and,

Whereas, the Port of Douglas County is a county-wide port district with the same number of commissioner districts as Douglas County; and,

Whereas, the Port of Douglas County, per RCW 53.16 and RCW 29A.76 is required to use the commissioner districts adopted by the Douglas County Board of Commissioners,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Commissioners for the Port of Douglas County hereby ratifies and approves the legal descriptions of the revised port commissioner districts as attached hereto as Exhibit A, and as adopted by the Douglas County Board of Commissioners, as applicable to the County Commissioner Districts.

PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT 1

Commencing in Section 11, Township 22 North, Range 20 East, W.M. at the intersection of the southwesterly extension of the centerline of 9th. 




