**Cashmere Mill Site Woodwaste Removal Project Update**

The Phase 2 contract for construction with Tommer Construction on the Cashmere Mill Site Woodwaste Removal Project was deemed substantially complete and has wrapped up for the winter. One small project remains; to resurface Mill Road in the spring of 2015. Approximately 9.4 acres have been environmentally cleaned and an additional 10.4 acres environmentally cleaned and woodwaste removed, totaling 19.8 acres of remediated property. The Cashmere Mill Site Woodwaste Removal Project is funded by a grant received from the Department of Ecology utilizing dedicated funding from the Model Toxics Control Act Fund.

**Pangborn Memorial Airport (PMA)**

**Pangborn Airport Projects Update**

The Port of Chelan County Commissioners, acting as the Pangborn Memorial Airport Governing Board, approved a Scope of Services Amendment with Stantec Consulting for additional engineering services necessary for the Runway Extension Project. The Pangborn Airport Runway Extension Project is in Phase 1. Current work includes grading, utility relocations such as moving the US Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) irrigation lines, and demolition of unnecessary structures. Current activities and updates can be found on the Pangborn Airport Facebook page and YouTube Page. Total cost of the Runway Extension Project could reach \$30 million, with \$27 million provided by FAA funds and \$3 million in local funds provided by The Port of Chelan County (\$2.1 million) and the Port of Douglas County (\$900,000). No airport delays are anticipated during this Phase of the project.
