Pangborn Memorial Airport Sewer Connection Complete

The Port of Chelan County Commissioners, acting as the Pangborn Memorial Airport Governing Board, deemed the Pangborn Airport Terminal Sewer Project as substantially complete. The connection to sewer increases the capacity for more passengers through the terminal as well as eliminates the septic maintenance costs.



Old Grant Road and Union Avenue to be Vacated

The realigned Grant Road, Union Avenue, and Airways Avenue have been completed. The process has begun to officially vacate the old roadways, transferring ownership to Pangborn Airport and a few neighboring property owners. Douglas County will finalize the process in January 2016. The construction of the extended runway will begin in Spring 2016. The Runway Extension Project is funded by the Federal Aviation Administration (90%) and a local match (10%) provided by the Port of Chelan County and Port of Douglas County.
