Pangborn Memorial Airport Master Plan Update

The Port of Chelan County Commission, acting as the Pangborn Memorial Airport Governing Board, approved entering into an agreement with Mead and Hunt, Inc. to update the Pangborn Memorial Airport Master Plan. Trent Moyers, Pangborn Airport Director, and Mitch Hooper of Mead and Hunt, Inc. presented the scope of work including multiple opportunities for public input over the yearlong process to create the plan. The FAA requirement to update the Master Plan will be 90% paid for by the FAA.

Pangborn Memorial Airport Runway Extension Project Update

Trent Moyers, Pangborn Airport Director, updated the Airport Governing Board on current construction progress on the Pangborn Airport Runway Extension Project. Taxiway A and A5 are ready for paving starting April 18, 2016. Construction has focused on Taxiway A and A5 creating nighttime runway closures to remove existing pavement. Closures were scheduled around Commercial Air service operations. A few unforeseen cancellations did occur recently due to a weather conditions combined with a shortened runway due to construction. Upon completion of the Runway Extension Project, the 7,000 foot runway will help reduce some weather related cancellations.
