**OLDS STATION BUSINESS PARK SHOWS 42% INCREASE IN
EMPLOYMENT**

Employment in the Port of Chelan County’s 51-acre Old Station Business Park in Wenatchee surged 42% over the last year. “As our community continues to deal with the loss of jobs from the ALCOA curtailment, it is great to see 184 additional jobs created in the Business Park over the last year”, said Commission President JC Baldwin.

Every July the Port conducts a census of employees in the Business Park. In July 2015 the business park had 433 employees. This number had grown to 617 by July 2016. The Port also captures where employees reside who work in the business park: 67% reside in Chelan County, 29% reside in Douglas County, 2% reside in Grant County and the remaining 2% reside outside the region.

Below is a list of business park tenants, in alphabetical order. The Olds Station Business Park consists of 9 buildings on 26 acres. There are no vacancies in any of the industrial buildings. The Port also owns approximately 24 undeveloped acres within the Business Park which are available for lease. All property is fully served by utilities, including the “Horan Block”, which is more than 14 acres in size.
