## New Grant Available for Small Businesses Impacted By COVID 19

Over the last year, Washington State has provided small businesses throughout the state with more than \$125 million in grants to address the economic outfall of COVID-19. This effort continues with a new round of grant opportunities focused on brick and mortar businesses. Businesses in Chelan and Douglas counties are eligible to receive grants.

The Washington State Department of Commerce is launching the new grant program using Federal CARES Act funds; Working Washington Round 4 on March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

**Priorities for funding include:** 

- Businesses required to close.
- Businesses with lost revenue as a result of closure.
- Businesses with added expenses to maintain safe operations.
- Equitable distribution of grant funds across the state and to businesses owned and operated by historically disadvantaged individuals.
